**Eligibility:** Applicant must be a senior boy or girl graduating from the WFS trade territory. We encourage, but do not require, he/she to be seeking a degree or certificate in agricultural studies.

**Selection:** The ability to succeed at the school of choice will be a major criterion for the selection of the scholarship winner. Primary consideration will be given to applicants whose high school academic performance is high and have demonstrated the qualities of leadership, industry, integrity and good high school and community citizenship. Other considerations would be patronage of WFS by applicant's parent and/or guardian and financial need.

The selection committee will consist of WFS' Member Relations Committee (which is made up of four members of the WFS Board of Directors).

**Terms:** The Scholarship award will be paid after the first quarter or semester of the school year upon proof to the local scholarship committee that the applicant had maintained at least a "C" average. If not attained the first quarter or semester, the scholarship may be awarded after a subsequent quarter or semester, once they have maintained that level.
